Participate as a volunteer for the EYE2025:

What's the EYE?

The **European Youth Event (EYE)** unites around 10.000 young people biennially at the heart of EU democracy. **EYE2025**, on 13-14 June in Strasbourg, offers debates, workshops, performances, and more. The **EYE Village** fosters activism and creativity through youth-driven initiatives and diverse perspectives.

What will EucA do?

EucA will be one of the activity organizers at the EYE Village, supporting the European Youth Forum. We will represent our network of colleges and higher education institutions in our stand and we will engage over 200 young Europeans with our EYE Quiz Tournament!

The EYE Quiz Tournament 2025 (EQT) is an engaging quiz competition that challenges young people to understand the functioning of the EU, the impact of EU policies in everyday life, and European values and rights. This second edition is planned to be held during the European Youth Event 2025.

What will be my role in the EYE2025?

As a volunteer, you will support the EucA team at the EYE Village.

- **Before the event:** You will attend the online onboarding and collaborate with EucA (max 3 meetings before the EYE).
- **During the event in Strasbourg:** Your primary role will be to assist with the EYE Quiz Tournament: help manage event operations, guide participants, and ensure a seamless and engaging experience. Moreover, you will be helping the EucA team in EucA's stand, promoting internationalization activities and opportunities for students within the EU.



- **After the event**, you will receive an **EucA Certificate of Training**, reflecting the hours you contributed to the event. Here's a brief **agenda** for the event:
 - **April / May 2025**: Max 3 Meetings to prepare for the EYE event
 - **Thursday 12 June 2025**: Arrival
 - **Friday 13 June 2025**: Support EucA activities during the EYE with a strong focus on the preparation and implementation on-site of the EYE Quiz Tournament
 - **Saturday 14 June 2025**: Support EucA activities during the EYE

When can I apply for this opportunity?

The application period will be open from **Friday, 14 February to Friday, 21 February 2025**. During this time, candidates are encouraged to submit their applications.

Once the application period closes, the most suitable candidates will be **selected and contacted** for an online onboarding session with the EucA team. During this session, candidates will receive detailed information and guidance on the EYE Staff registration process and the specific roles to cover.

What are the criteria?

1. Be a student from a [college, university, or residence member of EucA](#).
2. Be a national or resident in the following countries: Germany, Slovenia, Poland, and Hungary.
3. Strong interest in EU-funded projects and EU affairs.
4. Fluent in English both oral and written.



How should I apply?

To apply for this opportunity, you will need to complete the [registration form](#) with your personal information, answer a few motivational questions, and upload your CV along with a one-page cover letter. Please ensure that both documents are merged into a single PDF file with a maximum size of 3 MB.

Will I have any economic compensation?

As an EucA Volunteer, you will have covered:

- **Travel expenses up to 150 EUR round-trip.** (For must coordinate your ticket purchases with EucA: You will be asked to purchase the tickets in advance to secure your participation, while EucA will take care of your accommodation. You will be reimbursed once the event is concluded, no later than 30 days).
- **Three nights' accommodation** (12, 13 and 14 June) in a shared room.
- **All meals.**

Please note that since you will be participating as volunteers, no further financial compensation will be offered.
